The Warren Township Supervisors met at the Municipal Building at 7:00 PM. All were present. Chairman, Mark Wheaton opened the meeting with the flag salute being given.

The Secretary's minutes were read and approved.

The Treasurer's report was given as follows:

State- \$166344.61

General - \$330088.89

Rental & Donation - \$8953.59

OLD BUSINESS

Cleanup Day was a big success. The cost of the dumpsters was \$970.01. We received a check from Weitsman for \$577.14 for metal and \$218.00 was collected for tire disposal. The total cost for the day was \$174.87.

All 3 supervisors and the secretary and their spouses attended the convention. It was decided everyone would stay for the whole three days next year.

Fred and Janice met with Dottie from FEMA regarding Tropical Lee and she agreed to apply for a further grant for flooding in the amount of \$84,000. It was not determined when we could expect the money.

The pavilion materials have been ordered. After a phone conference with DCNR today, we realized the amount of paperwork and bidding issues were going to be overwhelming with all the flooding issues we have been faced with. Jerry Abell made the motion and Mark Wheaton seconded to negate the grant and just do the park using our own funds. Janice will notify Jay Schriebman from DCNR.

NEW BUSINESS

A new bridge deck has been installed across the creek for the walking path. Fred will be removing several trees.

Mark asked when the chicken barbeque pit would be moved. The firemen do have the new plans for a new pit.

Fred reported that the cost of REDCODE would be \$.56 per person in Township as per information that COG has received.

The convention was discussed. A seminar on the Impact fee was held. It was much the same discussion that Fred had attended in Towanda. Fred also attended a meeting on Blight in Your Neighborhood. This seminar discussed fallen down buildings, etc. Unfortunately, if an ordinance is enacted, it would subject everyone in the township to dispose of buildings even though it did not impact the community in any way.

Mark attended the Flood Plain meeting. Our Flood Ordinance needs to be reviewed by DCNR. Janice has copied and sent it to them. We will need to compare old and new flood maps to insure that residents are aware they are now in a flood plain or have been removed from one.

We will advertise the availability of flood maps for perusal by our residents.

Agency on Aging is requesting a 70" TV be installed in the auditorium. They would be willing to pay one-half of the cost. This was tabled until further discussion can be held on whether to mount on a wall or make portable.

Fred presented the cost of a Dodge Ram 1 ton dump truck at \$67,000. He will do further checking.

All bills were reviewed and paid.
