The Warren Township Supervisors met at the Municipal Building for their regularly scheduled meeting at 5:00 PM. All were present. Chairman Mark Wheaton opened the meeting with the flag salute being given.

The Secretary's report was read and approved. Fred made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Jerry seconded.

The Treasurer's report was given as follows:

OLD BUSINESS

Park Inspection is complete! Hallelujah!! A letter received from the inspector. All paperwork has been sent to Harrisburg for final approval.

The storage shed and the salt brine and calcium tanks have been tabled for another month.

NEW BUSINESS

A letter was received from the Bradford County Library requesting a donation for 2015. Jerry made a motion to send a \$500 donation for 2015. Mark seconded and motion carried. This figure will be put in budget for next year.

Correspondence

A letter was received from Little Meadows Fire and Ambulance association requesting a donation from 2014 (fees received in 2015) Impact Fees in the amount of 5% - 10% of the amount received. This will be discussed at the budget meeting.

A letter was received from the committee for the Bradford County Veterans Memorial Park requesting a time to come and present the overview of their project. That letter was tabled until next meeting.

Road Master Report

Much material is being put on roads. Since 09/10/2014, 5473 tons of materials have been placed on Jones, Reagan Hill, Turnpike, Wagner, Carey, Montrose Turnpike, Wheaton and Thomas Road. In October alone, 2380 tons of materials were placed on Wagner, Carey, Montrose Turnpike, Wheaton and Thomas Roads at a cost of \$30,871.09.

All bills were reviewed and paid.
