OLD BUSINESS

The brake hold has not been put on the dump truck yet. It is planned this will be completed before the end of September.

Letters were received from the commissioners denying our request for grants for the township. We received information from the Little Meadows Ambulance and Fire Company as requested as to what funding is still necessary for their new building. The cost of the building has been increased to \$980,000 due to the addition of a community room. The decision to give more money to this project has been tabled for now and will be discussed at the next meeting. The new storage shed will be started on Friday September 11. It will be completed the following week. The cost for this storage shed is \$44, 200 and is being built by S&L Builders. Their bid included the cost for prevailing wage.

Road Master Report

The roads improved this past month were: Bowen Road was built up on West End using materials taken off banks on Reagan Road. The South Warren Road was widened, new ditches installed and large sluice pipe lowered.

The Dirt and Gravel Road project on Kuhlman Road will be started next week. A bid will be placed in paper for the DSA materials and machine to lay it down.
