The Warren Township Supervisors met at the Municipal Building at 5:00 P.M. at their regularly scheduled meeting. All were present.

Chairman, Mark Wheaton, opened the meeting with the flag salute being given. The secretary's minutes were read and approved.

Old Business:

Fred checked with different dealers to have a new box placed on the 1991 Ford. He received quotes from Powell's at \$7898, Watson Diesel, \$13,600 and Bradco Supply, \$12,107.65. Mark made a motion to accept the quote from Powell's and Fred seconded. Motion carried.
