OLD BUSINESS

The secretary's bond has been raised to \$800,000.

The Coburn Hill Project will be completed this week. Bills will be submitted to Dirt & Gravel on June 10, 2019. Work was required to be completed by June 30, 2019. Hats off to our men for their diligence in getting this project done.

The three road workers attended the Dirt & Gravel Road Training in Montrose on May 8 and May 9th. This is a requirement in order to obtain funds for Dirt & Gravel Road projects.

We received a check from FEMA for \$3435.06 for immediate repairs to roads following the flood. We have others pending funds to receive. They will be reported as received.

The grader payments have been completed!

NEW BUSINESS

The sub-division for Marylea Wheaton was reviewed and approved.

Discussion was held regarding the necessary repairs on the roof. This repair will have to be advertised for bid.

The following **Road Master report** was given:

Coburn project nearly completed. The following roads were graded: Reagan, Turnpike, Hutchison, Kuhlman, Jones, Nichols. The dust control equipment has been set up. Dust control was put on Jones and Reagan Hill. Work was done on Freightliner and F800 is back from being painted and the starter is being worked on.

All bills were reviewed and paid.
