The Warren Township Supervisors met at the Township Building at 7:00 PM. All were present. Chairman, Gene Raymond opened the meeting with the flag salute being given.

The Secretary's minutes were read and approved.

The Treasurer's report was given as follows:

State Bills Paid: -\$8364.47 – Balance \$18877.56

General Fund Bills Paid - \$10546.11 – Balance - \$174,545.60

Rental and Donation Balance - \$4592.16

The bids were opened for the roller with representatives Terry Sheets from Bradco Supply, Albert Ashbury from Hall's Equipment and John Voda from B&K. Ryan Horne was present as an observer.

The bids were opened with following submissions:

Cleveland Bros – 2005 Cat with 398 hours-\$44,000

Hall's – 2004 Ingersoll Rand – 1300 hours-\$24,500

Bradco Supply – 2007 – 225 hours-\$49,000

B&K – 2004 Ingersoll-Rand – 2016 hours- \$38,500

Due to the variance in price and condition, the supervisors decided to research each machine more thoroughly before making a decision. They will table the decision for 1 week and then let bidders know of their decision.
