

Warren Township Supervisors- Minutes Regular Monthly Meeting- November 3rd, 2025

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, William Franklin; Supervisors present were, William Franklin, Mark Wheaton and Matt Wilks. Also, present were Lori Kepner, secretary/treasurer, and Joe Vrabel Roadmaster. There were several members of the public present at the meeting. The sign in sheet will be attached to the minutes. No members of the public had requested to be put on the agenda. One member of the public voiced his concerns about mud on Highland Lake Road, from the construction of a new home on that road. Vrabel will address that this week. Pledge to the Flag was recited.

Minutes: A motion was made by Wilks to accept the October 1st, 2025 Special meeting minutes, the October 6th, Regular Meeting minutes and all October 8th, 2025 budget meeting minutes. Wheaton seconded and all agreed. Wheaton suggested putting the heading Road Report before the comments where it starts: (Joe Vrabel gave the road report) Kepner will make sure it is clearly noted.

Treasurer's Report and Bills: were approved by motion made by Wilks and seconded by Franklin and all agreed.

Fire Dept and EMA: There is nothing new with the Fire Dept or the EMA.

Road Report: Joe Vrabel gave the road report. The building heat issues are still not resolved. They have been working roads as needed; there were 10 different spots that needed graded again. They have been cleaning up after the wind storms and cleaning ditches as needed. Brush cutting of limbs along the roads that need it has started. This needs to happen so the plows along with school buses don't hit the branches during the snow season for safety reasons; and just for the general public as well. This only occurs within the township right of way. The new snow plow has been delivered from Bradco off of the Costars program. Joe will start to get the equipment ready for the winter season!

New Business: Correspondence and emails were distributed. There is nothing new with permits/building permits. There were no new well NOI received. The Township had one subdivision application received for Shaddock. The board found no adverse comment to the subdivision. The board will move forward with the paperwork to reduce the speed limit on various roads with PennDOT. They will hold a budget work session meeting on November 10th, 2025 at 5pm; Wilks made the motion and Wheaton second. All agreed.

Old Business. There is nothing new with the grants for an addition to the Township building for a shower unit. There is nothing new to report on the Seniors Grant program.
