

Warren Township Recycle Regulations

Newspaper

Colored and black newsprint is accepted. Leave all inserts. Do not mix other paper and keep dry. Keep loose; do not bag or bundle.

Magazines

Magazines and catalogs only. Keep loose; do not bag or bundle.

Aluminum Cans

Rinse well. Crushing is optional. Do not include tin cans.

Glass Bottles

Separate by color; green, brown, and clear. Rinse well, remove lids and rings.

Corrugated Cardboard

Corrugated cardboard only. Look for ridges between layers. Does not include cereal, macaroni or tissue boxes. Keep dry. Do not bundle.

Plastic Bottles and Jugs

Plastic bottles and jugs with narrow neck only. Rinse well, labels can remain, remove lids. Includes soda bottles, milk bottles, laundry detergent and shampoo bottles. DOES NOT include butter tubs, baggies, Tupperware, grocery bags, lawn chairs, buckets, vinyl siding, etc.

[Note: Community groups will separate aluminum cans and plastic bottles that are recyclable for deposit refund.](#)
