

June 10, 2013

The Warren Township Supervisors met at the Township building at 5:00 PM for their regularly scheduled meeting. All were present. Chairman Mark Wheaton opened the meeting with the flag salute being given.

The secretary's minutes were read and approved. Mark made a motion to accept and Jerry seconded. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report was given as follows:

Plgit General - \$4884.68

First Citizens Savings - \$137380.65

PSB Impact Account - \$315456.41

State - \$144534.62

Jerry made a motion to accept the treasurer's report and Mark seconded. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

We have not received a check from Weitsman for scrap metal so a final report on Clean-Up Day was not given.

The \$300 was sent to the library.

The benches and tables for the park have been ordered at a cost of \$12505.00 using a company who is State Contract.

The new tables were purchased for the building as had been voted on at the December 10, 2012 meeting.

The supervisors voted to purchase a 10' plow from Bradco under resolution 2013-2 at an approximate cost of \$10,000. This purchase will be made using Impact Fee monies.

NEW BUSINESS

Haas Landscaping had sent a bid package for trees and shrubs for the park. The bids were advertised to be opened at this meeting.

Bids were received from:

BS Landscaping - \$9895 and \$75 per yard for mulch

The Good Earth Landscaping - \$9949 and \$55 per yard for mulch

York Landscaping - \$9857 and \$42 per yard.

Mark made a motion to accept the bid from York Landscaping and Jerry seconded. Motion carried.

A resolution (2013-3) was signed by Supervisors regarding Prevailing Wage and will be sent to PSATS

Secretary Janice Young gave a report to the supervisors on road materials purchased with state funds during March and April. 2659.80 tons of materials were purchased at a cost of \$32827.00.

ROAD REPORT

Reagan Hill Road at Strobe End has had DSA placed— pot holes repaired

Painter Road and South Warren Road have had materials placed.

All bills were reviewed and signed. Meeting adjourned at 7:00 PM
